About the program:

The First Year begins with an emphasis on script analysis and an introduction to the tools found in "An Actors Companion", which help an actor to find more ease, spontaneity and clarity. The class continues with scene study, acting for the camera, Shakespeare and monologues. The First Year concludes with a Barrow Group community showcase. In the Second Year students begin with advanced scene study, where the focus is on self-diagnosis, and then take classes in stage combat, clowning, voice and Alexander Technique.

The Second Year, building on what students learned from the showcase in the first year, culminates with an invited Industry Showcase. Performance opportunities include a monologue showcase, an invited industry showcase, and readings. In addition to class work, apprentices will gain valuable experience in running an award winning off-Broadway theatre company, meet other industry professionals and refine their own artistic goals.
