COURSE: FILM / TV Acting Class I: The Tools

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This six-week on-camera course focuses on film and television scripts and specific tools used in the medium. This workshop highlights quick and powerful ways to make your performance more natural and spontaneous. Limited class size allows for significant feedback and on-camera work.

During the duration of this class you will be working on your on-camera performance, and continuing your study of The Barrow Group technique and tools. The main focus will be on bringing the physical life of each scene to the camera.

Students will review taped work at the end of every class– no videotapes or links will be given out.

Weeks Two and Three – Terminology, First scene with tools and filming

Weeks Three and Four – Scene work and continuity

Week 6 – Audition Technique
